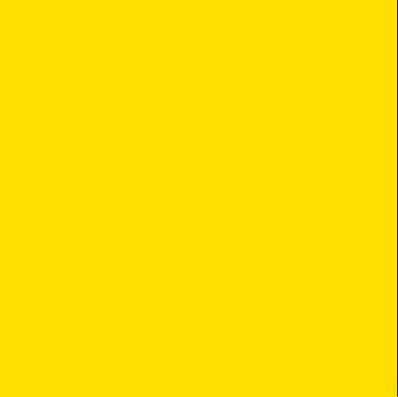
Work experience

If your child doesn't feel ready for an apprenticeship yet, a work experience placement with Arnold Clark is a great way to get involved.

- We offer work experience for a huge range of disciplines across all our branches, all year round.
- Out of our 161 apprentices in Scotland last year, only 14% did work experience with us, so we want to change this.
- Work experience can lead directly to an apprenticeship – so make it count!

Entry requirements:

- Aged 16 or over.
- Gained or working towards National 4 or 5 qualifications or GCSE A-C for England – subjects vary according to course.
- Must be literate, numerate and keen to learn.



What does an apprenticeship with Arnold Clark involve?
